ABOUT THE PLAY - The play focuses on the trials and tribulations of an Irishman, an American and an Englishman (Edward, Adam, and Michael) who are kidnapped and held hostage by unseen Arabs in Lebanon. As the three men strive for survival they also strive to overcome their personal and nationalistic differences. The three men have little to unite them beyond being human in the same small space. Yet somehow, together, they determine to ward off madness and forestall despair.

The play mixes humour, along with improvisation, role-playing, music and debate which become vital survival mechanisms for the three men trapped alone with nothing but their thoughts and one another.

CAST

Edward - An Irish journalist. Bit of a joker.

Adam - An American doctor. He has been held hostage longer than the others. Likes to exercise hard!

Michael - An English academic. A little reserved and totally different from the other two.

The play takes place entirely within the confines of a cell.
